Food Hub

Lisa Cox and Liz Malcolm represented Foodhub at a presentation of \$2000 by the Rotary Club of Port Pirie at our meeting on Thursday. Most of the money was raised at the yearly Bowls Night and was topped up with club funds.

The Port Pirie Community Foodhub is run by Uniting CountrySA as a cut-price supermarket, in Florence Street, for the needy who are given referrals to its services. The site was set up in 2014 to provide access to low-cost food for those in in the region who need it.

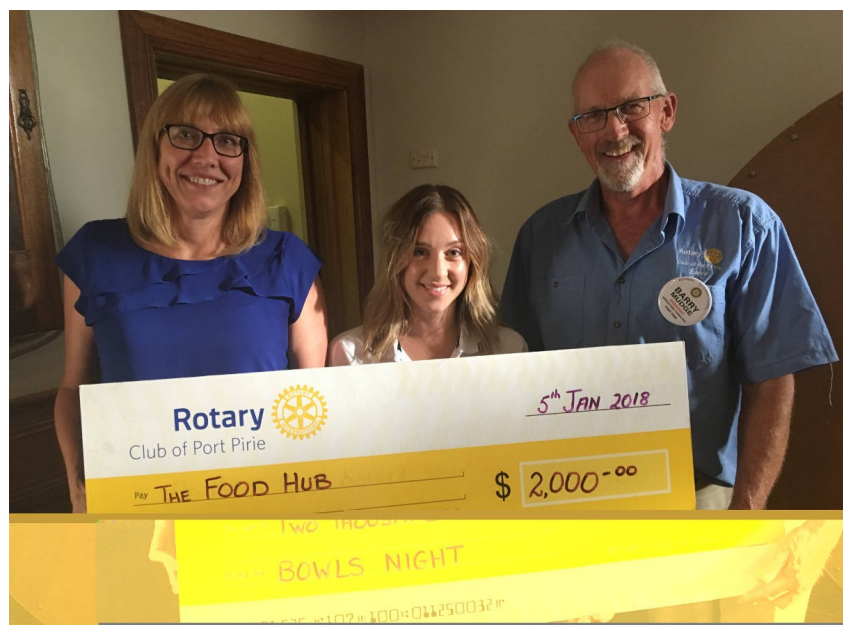
It has no ongoing funding and is managed by Uniting CountrySA. The shop is staffed by a group of wonderful volunteers. Last financial year alone they dedicated more than 5100 hours to the service. This enabled the provision of enough food to those in need for about 88,000 meals.

The service cannot be provided without the support of the community which is why Rotary's generous donation is so very appreciated and makes such a huge difference.

"We also greatly appreciated donations of food which can be delivered directly to the Foodhub at 140 Florence Street between 10am and 2.30pm from Monday to Friday," Liz said.
