Kuol's Trip

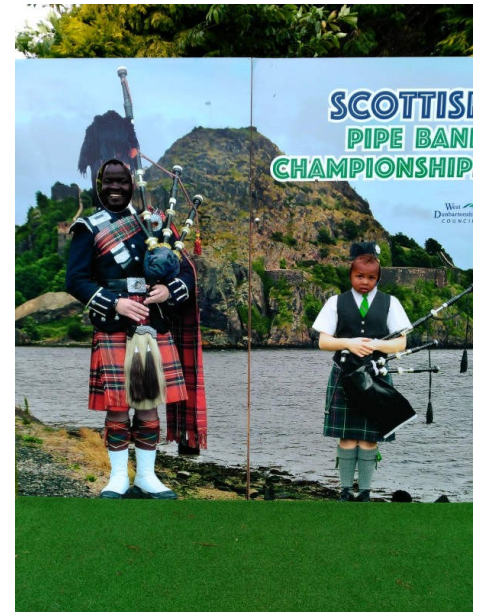
