Rotarians call in

MUDGE leads take-over of Recorder office.

Leading citizens of Port Pirie will become the new staff of the Recorder.

It will be a voluntary operation with a sausage sizzle every weekend.

Tennis organisers have hit the "sweet spot" with a \$135,000 courts upgrade that will ensure the return of the international tennis classic.

The satellite tournament is expected to held in 2018

or 2019 after missing the calendar this year because of the sub-standard state of the courts.

Ten courts will be upgraded in the project managed by Tennis Australia. Work could be finished in time for the summer season.

President of the Port Pirie and District Tennis Association, Dennis Buchanan said the final piece of the jigsaw was a \$60,000 grant from the recreation and sport depart-

ment. This will be linked with \$40,000 from Port Pirie Regional Council, \$10,000 from Tennis Australia and \$25,000 from the association.

Mr Buchanan said the courts would be resurfaced to meet standards required for the tournament to be held again. "This will give us the 10 courts so we can get the classic back again," he said.

He said the event's timing

was up to Tennis Australia, which was revamping its tournaments schedule.

"As long as we can get it, we will work in with it," he said.

He said all parties concerned with the project would meet soon.

The resurfacing would take roughly less than a month depending on weather.

Mr Buchanan said the upgrade was a requirement stipulated by authorities before the tournament could
