Elaborated further on the Emergency Relief Training. Along with other emergency services, Rotary's role was explained should it be required during an emergency situation.

GUEST SPEAKER

Philip Amato

Philip was born and bred in Port Pirie. He is married with one son.

Although he tried employment elsewhere it didn't seem to last long. Even Roxby for one week, but that was because The Terrace deli came up for sale and his wife thought it would be good venture for them.

This was after he had been at the gas Company for 30 years and interesting past Port Pirie Rotarian Claus Newbaur was his boss. The gas company restructured and essentially closed operations in Port Pirie and Philip credits Claus for leading him down the right path and giving him the correct tools to move forward.

As a result he now works for APA who have assets of over \$20 Billion across Australia. They own and manage the pipeline infrastructure and Philips job is to assign contractors to do jobs on the gas network to people homes. His coverage area is from Wallaroo to Port Lincoln.

Philip is an avid supporter of Junior Soccer and about 400 kids play every weekend. The local Association send 80 kids away twice a year and they are great ambassadors for Port Pirie.

He is also Vice President of the Blessing of the Fleet committee, of which PP Dino Gadaleta is the President. They were also instrumental in the construction of the Boat Museum at the bPort Pirie boat ramp.

Philip also spoke about the history of the Italians in Port Pirie and recalled a story about how the Italians in King street were all considered a security threat when Italy allied with Germany during the wars.
