Guest Speaker

Roger Kleinig Baptist Pastor

Current pastor at the Port Pirie Baptist Church talked about his life experiences and his journey to finding god.

Roger is a Laura boy born and bred, his father was born there and his grandfather was one of the founding managers of the Laura Milling Company. He grew up around the mill and remembers helping to demolish the old mills when they were shut down 1972.

He did well at school and was encouraged to head off to University, that lasted about 3 months before realizing he had had enough of study. He took a gap year then tried again but it wasn't to be, he did however meet his wife Glenda there. They have been married 40years and have 4 children.

He was a wondering soul trying his hand at numerous odd jobs before settling back in Laura and becoming a potter in 1984. He did that for quite some time but he had a yearning and a searching in his heart, he had graduated as a teenager into agnosticism, taken up atheism and then new ageism.

After his father died he did a lot of soul searching, eventually his wife brought a bible home and that changed his life. The profound feeling of being loved unconditionally. That was the beginning of the rest of his life, the journey of how he could serve god and do his will. He went to bible college in Adelaide one day a week to become a pastor (no trouble studying this time). Since 2011 he has lived part time in Pirie and spends weekends in Laura.
