## Ingrid Meissner Vocational Talk

Ingrid was given some wise words of advice from some helpful Rotarians - watch your jokes, don't speak for an hour and don't use slides – prior to her talk. Not sure what they thought Ingrid was going to present.

Born in Mt Barker she lived most of her life in the Adelaide Hills and 2.5 years ago moved to Port Pirie. Her Mother is Dutch and father German, there house in Mount Barker was situated on 5 acres next to a creek. Half of her life was spent in that creek, collecting frogs, tadpoles and yabbies'. When she left school she studied fashion design for a short period in Geelong. Got married at 19 and was a mum when she was 21 and 2<sup>nd</sup> at 24, she is a grandmother of 1, soon to be 2.

When she was married she was actively involved in many business, mechanical, service station, transportation and a farm. After a while she wanted to work with people, she started studying counselling but after a year her marriage ended. Believing counselling wouldn't lead to a job she changed to a Social Work degree.

Being a social worker, "a job no one wants to do but will tell you how you should do it".

As a social worker you are always dealing with people in crisis and you are often asked how you manage. You have to develop some strategies and what works for her is photography. It gives her a creative outlet and it gets her outside.

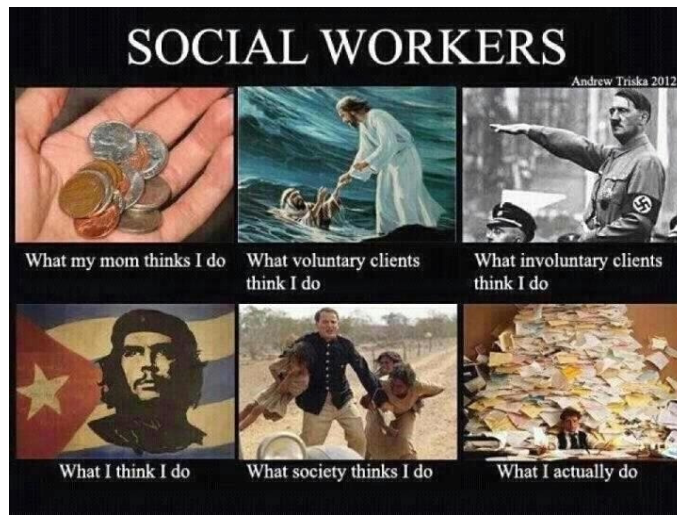
She has worked in Aged Care, disability, mental health, multiple sclerosis and now is a palliative care and community social worker. She covers a wide region from Port Broughton to Wilmington and NSW border to so is often out and about in all these different cars. Like a test drive every 2<sup>nd</sup> day, some of the cars have interesting features like keyless entry and lane departure systems.

Her work involves many different community and government agencies, with many different forms. Her biggest frustration is that they are always changing and so lots of time spent researching who does what.

She is no longer shocked by the dreadful things that happen to people however she is still amazed by peoples strength, determination, resilience and joy in the midst of the worst situations. "My job is not to rescue people, my job is to empower people".
