## Melinda Alley & Jasmine Weiss Occupational Therapy

Melinda and Jasmine are fourth year Occupational Therapy students.

Their aim is to 'create a dual indoor-outdoor therapeutic space that promotes activity participation, health and wellbeing' at the Port Pirie Hospital. An associate, Bard Tyler identified a need in the hospital to create a welcoming, engaging space for patients and their families. This was due to many patients being unmotivated to leave their rooms, with reports of deconditioning and extended stays in hospital also presenting as issues. Since then we have created a detailed proposal outlining how our project will develop across a nine-week period and remain sustainable into the future. The focus of the project is to update the patient lounges in wards A and C.

They are currently in week 5 of their 9 week project. The first four weeks were the Needs Analysis phase which involved surveys of Staff and Patients.

Patients and staff have prioritised a need for more comfortable and safe furniture within the patient lounges; such that it would be appropriate for clients following surgery. A lot of the current furniture poses as a safety risk due to the lack of chairs with armrests and adjustable seat heights that are important to assist with safe transfers following hip and knee reconstructions. Staff and patients also identified that the furniture is mismatched, especially in Ward C, which can be an eyesore when entering the lounges and some of the items have small rips.
