Dr Helen Robertson Donkey Breeding & Showing

Dr Helen gave us an entertaining (must have been fascinating as well judging by the number of questions) glimpse into the world of donkeys.

Some Interesting Facts

Donkeys come from [Africa](#) and the [Middle East](#), where they were tamed more than 5,000 years ago. These slow animals are used today as work animals in poor countries; they carry materials, plow fields and draw up water. Donkeys are related to [horses](#) and [zebras](#), but they have much longer ears than either one and while usually smaller than horses they are stronger pound for pound.

Donkeys are much more of an all-terrain animal than horses and are in fact a highly intelligent animal despite popular misconception. While they have a reputation for stubbornness but this is due to their highly developed sense of self preservation. It is difficult to force or frighten a donkey into doing something it sees as contrary to its own best interest or safety.

A **hinny** is a hybrid that is the offspring of a male horse and a **female donkey (a jenny)**. It is the reciprocal cross to the more common **mule**, which is the product of a **male donkey (a jack)** and a female horse.
