## National Disability Insurance

Huge growth in jobs and spending is expected in the Yorke and Mid North region in the wake of the National Disability Insurance Scheme. Up to 725 full-time equivalent jobs and \$100 million funding by the federal government has been outlined for the 11 council areas. The scheme will provide individualised care plans and funding to individuals with disability needs. Significant amounts of funding support could be available for people who will then be able to choose their care provider, empowering them with “choice and control”.

It is forecast that up to 1900 people will receive NDIS care plans in the region, an increase of almost 200 percent in people receiving disability support. Port Pirie Regional Council is expected to have the biggest increase in participants with an expected 450. To meet the demand for services under the new scheme, the local workforce in the region is expected to grow from 175 full-time equivalent roles to 725. Given the higher levels of casualisation and part-time work in the sector, the actual number of jobs and individuals required to fill them will be significantly higher.

Direct care workers will see the biggest demand growth with more than 400 full-time equivalent positions available. Allied health numbers are expected to triple in the region while major increases are also likely in planners and facilitators, transport, administrative and frontline support roles. The scheme was outlined to the Rotary Club of Port Pirie by Larissa Mackrill, who is the Disability Workforce Hub Co-ordinator, and Cr Alan Zubrinich, who is the independent chair of the Hub’s Steering Group.

The Yorke and Mid North Disability Workforce Hub, funded through the state government, connects job seekers with local employers, training providers and employment agencies to help fill local jobs in the disability sector. Ms Mackrill said it was an exciting time in the sector due to the employment growth and economic development



opportunities with the additional \$80 million coming into our region.

Mr Zubrinich said the scheme was the biggest social reform since the introduction of Medicare in the 1980s. He said it was all about “choice and control” for the individuals.
