Phytoremediation Dianah Mieglich

So the question on everyones lips of course was.... What is it?

Phytoremediation is the direct use of living green plants for in situ, or in place, removal, degradation, or containment of contaminants in soils, sludges, sediments, surface water and groundwater. **Phytoremediation** is: A low cost, solar energy driven cleanup technique.

What happens is that specific types of plants are grown in contaminated soil, and the amount of contamination decreases as the plants grow.

TLAP – The Targeted Lead Abatement Program and the Council joined forces to plant SunFlowers on a site on the Main Road. 5445 Helianthus annuum spp. was grown for 70 days. The planted area also had a “round house”, which was covered, in order to provide a base-line measurement from possible exposure to more airborne contaminants.

At the end of the duration, the plants were harvested by workers in PPE (personal protectice equipment), and the plants were disposed of as contaminated waste. Many of the plants were stunted.

The results of the program are not is as yet, but the work of TLAP continues in detecting and combating the lagacy of the lead problem. Further TLAP activities can be seen on their web site www.tlap.com.au
