## Georgia Tiller Exchange Student (returned)

Georgia gave us a glimpse of the time she spent in Germany on Exchange and even managed to impart some words of wisdom for the potential exchange students. She thought she was prepared but you really know nothing, but she quickly picked it up.

She had 3 host families and they were all amazing, her host brother really helped her with her German and to settle in. When the year was over it was difficult to leave as they felt like real family

Georgia spent the year in Germany in the small town of Emden, which is in the north coast of Germany on the border with the Netherlands. It is a major shipping port with approximately a million cars exported annually. Volkswagen has a plant there which employs around 10,000 people, the plant is actually larger than the town (combined with the vehicle shipping it makes Emden look more like a giant carpark than a town).

She went on quite a few trips (so many her father called her the exchange tourist), one trip was through 3 countries in 1 day. Her favourite place that she visited was Venice. The Germans love sausage they ate it with every meal, there is also no such thing as bad weather just inappropriate clothing so rain, hail or shine you go to school. She complained about the cold so much her host father she got a really attractive army grey full body thermal suit that she had wear out.
