Guest Speakers

The Scheduled Guest Speaker was a last minute cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances. Therefore Mr Peter Kretchmer and visiting former member and current members Peter Arnold and James Holyman are to make presentations.

Peter Kretchmer - President of St Peters Rotary Club advises after relocating to Adelaide he attended a couple of meetings with Ian Brett a well known former Port Pirie resident and decided to join them. Currently the club has 30 members (down from approx 60 previously). In Adelaide there are a number of clubs within a close geographical area, with small membership numbers, and subsequently St Peters have created a membership committee to assess this issue. The exception to this is the Cambeltown Club with 85 members.

The clubs biggest fundraising activity is the Linde Reserve Op-Shop. This operates between 8am-12pm each Saturday, with Op-Shop, BBQ tea and coffee etc, this generates approx \$1000 per week. Operates with 6 people each week rostered to attend being both Rotary members and friends of Rotary.

Meetings held weekly Tuesday at the Kensington Hotel 6pm I invite anyone to attend a meeting when they are in Adelaide.

Peter and James- Local council elections. he council is keen to work on the diversity in council members, currently 2 women and 8 men. We have never had a female Mayor in any of the previous 4 council area which are now combined. No one under 30 has been elected in the past 20 years. Lack of diversity could equate to lack of community representation. We need to also to keep in mind Regional considerations. An information night for anyone considering running for council is to be held 15th August and we encourage anyone interested or if you know of anyone who you believe would be a good contributor please ask them to make enquiries.
