Stories from Nepal

Mary and her husband Owen have spent nearly 14 years living in Nepal working as GP's initially and then as GP educators in the University Medical School.

She took us for a "Short Walk" with a Short Man – Sunil Khadka.

Sunil was involved in a vehicle rollover in his late teens and due to complications from the injuries he sustained left him unable to walk or even stand. Lack of medical care can turn a minor injury into a lifelong disability.

There were no support networks for the disabled in Nepal, so the disabled were often forced onto the street. He was determined to try and help these people.

When the local regional Hospital was closed he moved in and squatted (determined to stay unless physically removed). With a lot of determination what started as a place for disabled individuals to have place to sleep has grown into the Disabled and Helpless Rehabilitation and Service Center. Providing medical treatment and schooling opportunities for the disabled and those unable to afford to go to the local hospital.
