Guest Speaker

James Holyman

James was born in Tasmania, a child of the 60's. He is fifth generation Tasmanian on both sides with no convict connections (the first Holyman to settle did jump ship for a woman). He grew up with 3 brothers all keenly involved in sport. His parents had a great passion for food and wine, passing on the cooking gene to James and winemaking to his youngest brother (He runs a vineyard on the Tamar River, perhaps James may be able to provide a few samples)

He completed a Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Design (Architecture, Landscape Architecture & Town Planning) in Launceston before moving to Melbourne to do a Bachelor of Business with a major in Accounting. He did his accounting "penance" working for Ansett and was involved in the transition from paper tickets to electronic boarding passes. After Ansett (before the collapse) he moved to a role with the CFA in Victoria. During his 15 years there he had roles in Operations, Human Resources, Strategic Planning & Regional Services, while also being a volunteer for 2 brigades near his home. While with the CFA he was involved in several large events including Linton, which claimed the lives of 5 firefighters and six weeks working on the Black Saturday Fires. He was in the incident control centre but has very little recollection of that first Saturday. A big lesson was they had not trained for the trauma of receiving distress calls from distraught residence surrounded by fire and nothing you can do.

James has four children (2 boys & 2 girls) his youngest daughter is pregnant so he will soon be a very, very, very, very young grandfather. He has renovated 3 properties including his home in Victoria and his new place here can only be described as a renovators delight. While still keenly interested in sport, through basketball he has had 2 knee reconstructions while expressing an interest to take up the sport again his wife contacted Wheelchair Sports Victoria which started a long career in wheelchair basketball. The best part of this was that he could play with his daughter as the chair is a great leveller.

James also has a passion for sustainable living, his house in Victoria is of the grid (apart from a phone line) with solar power and rain water etc. He has also become a vegetarian to minimise his impact on the environment.

He has been pleasantly surprised by the warmth of the welcome he has received from the Port Pirie community (to his face at least) and the friendliness has exceeded his expectations.
